**ORDINANCE NO. 627**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF DENVER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHAPTER 192 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE IV – GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 192-35 – SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED; PARKING OTHERWISE PROHIBITED TO ADD A HANDICAP PARKING SPACE AT 625 MAIN STREET; AMENDING CHAPTER 192 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE IV – GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, TO ADD A NEW SECTION 192-36.1 TO PROHIBIT STANDING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES WHICH BLOCK FREE PASSAGE ON STREETS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH PENNSYLVANIA LAW.**

**BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Denver, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 192 of the Code of the Borough of Denver – Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV – General Parking Regulations, Section 192-35 – Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited, be and hereby is amended by adding the following to the table set forth therein:

<u>“STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>	<u>AUTHORIZED PURPOSE”</u>
Main Street	North	625 Main Street	Handicap Parking

Section 2. The Code of the Borough of Denver – Chapter 192 – Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV – General Parking Regulations, be and hereby is amended by adding the following Section 192-36.1 – Parking or Standing of Vehicles Prohibiting the Flow of Traffic:

“§192-36.1. Parking or Standing of Vehicles Prohibiting the Flow of Traffic.

It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, park or stand a vehicle on any street or any part of any street without leaving an unobstructed width of said street or part thereof opposite the vehicle free for the passage of other vehicles.”

Section 2. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded.

Section 3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, clauses, or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its enactment as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
