

Denver Borough's 2016 Street Improvement Projects

Listed below is a summary of the major street infrastructure improvement projects that are proposed for Denver Borough in 2016:

North 5th Street Reconstruction and Paving Project

This project includes the reconstruction of North 5th Street from Main Street to Pine Street by milling and removing the existing roadway, installing 10 inches of stone, three (3) inches of base, and two (2) inches of wearing course. Also, 525 feet of concrete curb and concrete gutter will be removed and new curbing will be installed.

The Borough's anticipates bidding these projects in March, 2016, and placing the project on a Summer 2016 construction schedule. The project should begin in June, 2016 and conclude in August, 2016.

2016 Crack Sealing Project

For one (1) week this spring the Borough will crack seal cracks and breaks in streets located in the following sections of the Borough: South 4th Street (Borough owned), South 6th Street, South Fifth Avenue, North 4th Street, Snyder Acres Development, and Old Park Village Development.
