Denver Borough Armed Forces Banner Program

Deadline for Banner Applications is July 11, 2018



Beginning in 2018, Denver Borough proudly introduces the “Denver Borough Armed Forces Banner Program” - a tribute to service men and women from Denver Borough who have served or are serving our country in a branch of the military.

Each individual banner will be unique and honor a specific Denver Borough service man or woman and will include a picture of the service member, his/her name, branch, and era of service. The program is non-political and non-partisan. This effort is to serve as a living memorial to those service men and women from Denver Borough that have served or are currently serving in our military branches.

Denver Borough Armed Forces Banners:

- Each banner will cost \$110.00 and will be limited to the first 94 applications.
- Banners will be installed on 50 wood poles located on North 6th Street, Main Street, and South 4th Street on a first come, first served basis. Each of these banners will measure 24-inches by 48-inches and will include a picture of the service member, his/her name, branch, and era of service.
- Banners also will be installed on 44 decorative fiberglass poles located on the 200 and 300 blocks of Main Street and in the Denver Memorial Park and Playground on a first come, first served basis. Each of these banners will measure 18-inches by 36-inches and will include a picture of the service member, his/her name, branch, and era of service.
- Will be available for review prior to printing for accuracy purposes, once the proof is signed off on by purchaser it is not the responsibility of the borough for any mistakes.
- The banners will hang in the Borough for two (2) years. At the conclusion of that period, the banners will be removed and the person or organization who purchased the banner will be given the banner.
- Available to any current or former resident of Denver Borough who has served and/or is serving in the Armed Services.

Ways and Benefits to Sponsoring a Banner:

- Family members and loved ones of Veterans may purchase a banner themselves.
