



## 2020 Denver Community Pool Season

Who is excited for Summer Swimming? The Borough of Denver is pleased to announce that the Denver Community Pool will be opening on **Saturday, June 20, 2020**. The guidelines below will be in place to keep everyone safe and healthy while at the Denver Pool.

### Membership Passes and Fees

- The Borough will begin to sell Pool passes starting **Monday, June 15, 2020**. The Membership Rates and Fees will be posted on the Borough's Facebook Page and Website. Please note, due to Covid-19 restrictions, you are required to wear a mask and socially distance when entering the Municipal Building.
- Patrons are encouraged to download the Pool Membership Application, complete and sign the application, and either email the form to [Mhession@denverboro.net](mailto:Mhession@denverboro.net) or drop the form off at the Municipal Building drop box during the week of June 8<sup>th</sup>.
- The initial opening of the Denver Community Pool will be limited to Members only and participating daycare facilities. This policy will be evaluated during the first two (2) weeks of the season and changes will be made accordingly.

### Important New Guidelines

- The Denver Community Pool will be open daily from June 20, 2020 to August 24, 2020 from 12:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Daily attendance at the Pool will be limited to 145 bathers at any one (1) time.
- Please wear your swimsuit to and from the Denver Community Pool to limit overcrowding in the changing rooms.
- Patrons are encouraged to practice social distancing in all areas of the Pool including the entrance, snack bar, grounds, and water. Stay with your party and remain a minimum of six (6) feet from other individuals.
- Patrons will be required to wear masks when entering the Pool facility. Masks are encouraged to be worn when not in the water. Masks should not be worn in the water.
- Chairs and benches will not be provided this summer. Please plan on bringing your own.

- The Pool Slide will not be used during the 2020 season due to potential issues with people lining up to use the slide.
- No recreation equipment will be distributed (basketballs, noodles, floats, kickballs).

#### Additional Precautions

- High touch areas in the restrooms, the entrance breezeway, and the pool railings and ladders will be disinfected throughout the day.
- Lifeguards will be supplied a face mask to wear when indoors or when interacting with a patron. Lifeguards will not wear a mask when working in a chair.
- Per CDC Guidelines, Pool staff will be making regular announcements to keep patrons informed about policies and guidelines.
